#### RIDE/DRIVE


Getting to Leggott is easy. We are located in Scunthorpe, North Lincolnshire, with transport links coming from afar. We run a variety of bus routes to ensure our students have a smooth journey.

If you are driving, you can park in our student car park adjacent to the college. You will need to purchase a car park permit from Student Services (included in your campus charge).

You can also walk if you live locally, or you may choose to cycle; we have bike sheds available on campus where your bikes can be stored safely.

#### **GETTING TO COLLEGE**

Students aged 16-18 years may be eligible for travel assistance from their Local Education Authority (LEA) Post-16 Travel Scheme. If you are intending to travel to college by bus and live MORE THAN 3 MILES from college you will need to apply for a yearly travel pass by 21st July 2023.

#### **NORTH LINCOLNSHIRE RESIDENTS**

North Lincolnshire Council

Details of the cost of a travel pass for 2023/2024 will be published by the end of July 2023. The current cost for a travel pass for 2022/2023 is £90.

Please be aware you must live MORE THAN 3 MILES away from the college to apply for this pass.

#### **COLLEGE CONTRACT BUS SERVICES**



The college contracts bus routes from the Goole/Doncaster/Grimsby/Market Rasen/Misterton/Gainsborough areas. The cost for a travel pass for 2023/2024 is £360 for the year or three termly instalments of £120.

#### **PAYMENTS**

#### **NORTH LINCOLNSHIRE RESIDENTS**

The cost for the travel pass for the academic year 2023/24 is £90 Payment is required in full before the student is given their pass.

Payments can be made via ParentPay from early September once you have received your log in details from the college. Alternatively can call Student Services on 01724 407050 to make the payment over the phone. The student is also able to pay via cash or cheque at Student Services.

## CONTRACT BUS SERVICES INC. NOTTINGHAMSHIRE/EAST YORKSHIRE

The cost for the travel pass for the academic year 2023/24 is £360 Payment is required before the student is given their pass.

Payments can be made via ParentPay from early September once you have received your log in details from the college.

Alternatively can call Student Services on 01724 407050 to make the payment over the phone. The student is also able to pay via cash or cheque at Student Services. We can also offer three termly instalments (Sept/Jan/Apr)

#### **FURTHER INFORMATION**

For all bus routes you should arrive at the bus stop at least 5 minutes before departure and signal the bus to stop

The bus will **NOT STOP** unless an indication is made to the driver that you wish to board or depart the bus

Students are not permitted to smoke on the bus (this includes e-cigarettes), nor be under the influence of, or take or consume prohibited drugs and/or alcohol.

Passes will not be given until payment has been made
