## HISTORY:

## ECONOMICS:

The UK signed the Paris Agreement on 12 December 2015, agreeing to combat climate change and to accelerate and intensify the actions and investments needed for a sustainable low carbon future. This led to the UK becoming the first major economy to pass a 'net zero emissions law', with the aim of becoming carbon neutral by 2050.

***Discuss whether the UK will still be able to achieve this target, given the current issues it is facing in dealing with the Covid pandemic.***

## POLITICS:

Research the following statement:

'The 3 traditional parties in the UK are no longer serving the interests of the British people.'
